

Lake Park HOA Pool Reservations

Lake Park will be using CourtReserve to schedule pool usage for the pools beginning with the Back pool opening on Monday, June 1st! The Front Pool is scheduled to open Saturday, June 6th. Please note, if you do not have a reservation you will be turned away at the gate and your access card will also be required. This policy will be strictly enforced due to usage limitations and social distancing requirements.

PLEASE ONLY REGISTER YOUR ACCOUNT USING THE PROVIDED LINK! ESTABLISHING A COURTRERESERVE ACCOUNT THROUGH THEIR WEBSITE WITHOUT USING THE PROVIDED LINK WILL NOT PROVIDE ACCESS TO CENTENNIAL LAKES RESERVATIONS.

PLEASE SETUP ONLY ONE ACCOUNT PER HOUSEHOLD AND ADD FAMILY MEMBERS UNDER THE ONE FAMILY ACCOUNT! YOU WILL NEED A RESERVATION FOR EACH FAMILY MEMBER PLANNING TO ACCESS THE POOL.

Also, CourtReserve has an app (search CourtReserve on Google Play or Apple App store) that can be used on both Apple and Android devices.

Reservations are initially being limited to 50 individuals at the Back Pool and 30 individuals at the Front pool per reservation period, and reservations are limited to 1 reservation per day and 4 reservations per week. We expect these restrictions will be altered as attendance is gauged and restrictions change. Given the limitations on attendance, guests are not currently allowed.

The Back pool is scheduled to be open weekdays from 12:00 PM – 8:00 PM with 2 ½ time slots and weekends from 10:00 AM – 7:30 PM with 2-hour time slots. Weekday reservation periods will be followed by 15-minute transition and cleaning periods, and these cleaning and transition periods will be 30-minutes on weekends when higher usage is expected.

The Front pool is scheduled to be open weekends only from 10:00 AM – 7:30 PM with 2-hour time slots. Weekend reservation periods will be followed by cleaning and transition periods of 30-minutes.

This will be a different pool season with unique challenges, and we ask that each of you as homeowners be cognizant of the challenges in opening and operating pools this season, and help us and the pool staff in our efforts to provide a safe and fun environment for all homeowners!
